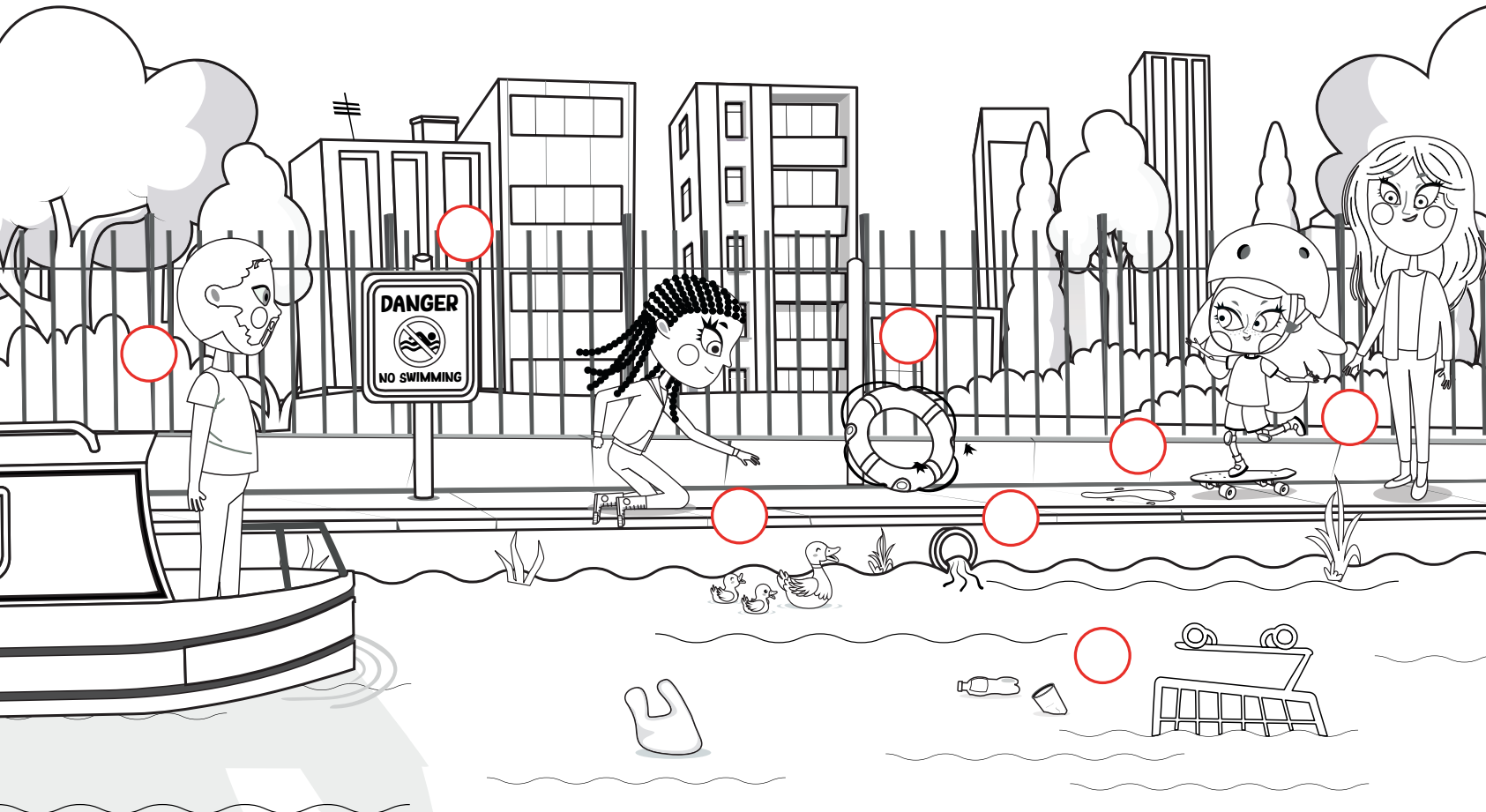


# Water Safety by inland water



## DANGERS

Can you match the following advice with the dangers on the picture?

- 1 Don't go into the water to get lost toys or play with wild animals. Follow the Water Safety Code
- 2 Litter and discarded items underwater can hurt or trap you
- 3 Beware of litter and slippery surfaces (e.g. wet stone or puddles)
- 4 Wear a life jacket when on the water to help if you fall in
- 5 Safety signs give information to keep you safe
- 6 Stay within arm's reach of an adult when you are in, on or around the water
- 7 Rescue equipment may be missing or broken
- 8 Water could be polluted. We don't want to encourage any entering of the water unless it is clearly a lifeguarded lido
