We enjoy going outside in all weathers but we cannot do this if your child does not have weather appropriate clothing.

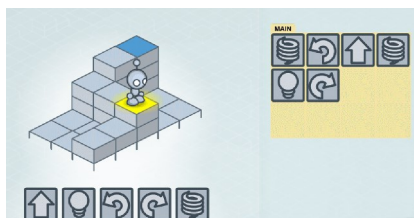
