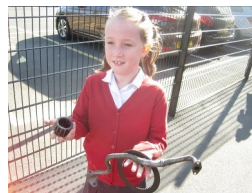

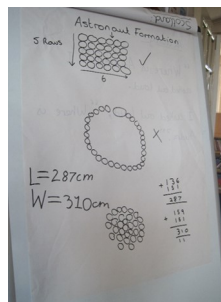

What was that explosion on the school field?

A rocket ship crash landed on our school field. We hunted down and collected the parts that had fallen from it and discussed what they could be and what they could have been used for. This helped set the scene for our 'Stargazers' mission - to build a class sized rocket ship, big enough to fit our whole class and class teacher inside!





So how can we figure out the dimensions of our rocket ship?

Year 5 discussed the seating formation first and decided to physically try this out in the classroom. From this, we were able to find the length, width, height and diameter that the rocket ship would need to be.

They then challenged ourselves to convert these measures between cm, mm and m.

PE KIT

As you know PE is a very important part of your child's education and for the new academic year we have developed a new timetable to ensure all children have clear regular PE Sessions indoors and outdoors (weather permitting). In addition to this, we will continue the Daily Mile. As a result, your child will need to have their PE kits in school every day and it does not need to be taken home after every lesson as it can get forgotten for the next lesson.

Due to health and safety reasons wearing the appropriate clothing in school is VERY important. Please can you ensure that your child is provided with a white t-shirt and black shorts for indoor PE and a white t-shirt and black or dark jumper and jogging bottoms / track suit for outdoor PE.

These can be purchased very cheaply from places like Sports Direct, Tesco, Asda or Matalan.

Trainers or plimsolls are required.

We also have a no jewellery policy for health and safety reasons and children will be required to remove their own ear rings. All our local secondary schools have strict guidelines on uniform and PE kit and if the boundaries are set in Primary School then the children will see a consistent approach throughout their education.

Health and fitness in young children is a priority for young people, their parents and their teachers across the country and is also a high priority for the Government. Please ensure your child always has their PE kit in school, as weekly physical activity and the learning of sports skills is essential for their mind and body.

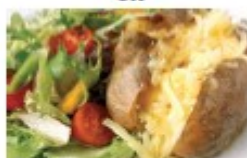
