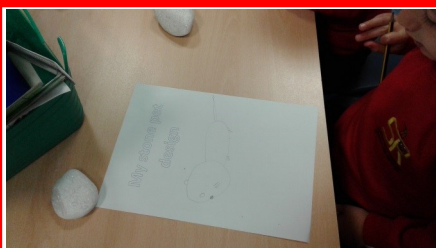

Year 4 Art

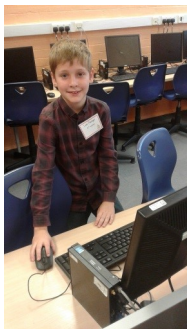
Year 4 have been creating their advertisements for their cinema experience this week.

Mrs. Darwood-Brown also took a small group to create Usherette trays in order to sell our snacks and souvenirs during the event.

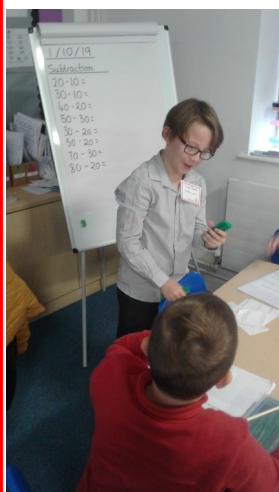
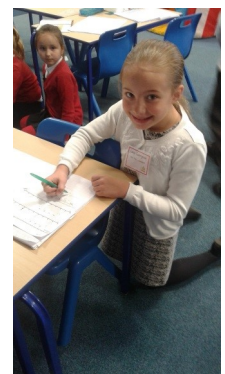
