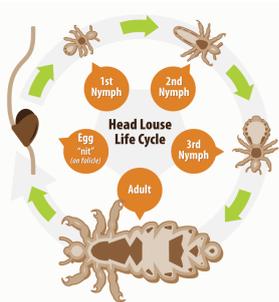


WATCH OUT NITS ARE ABOUT!

Can we please ask that you check your child's hair on a regular basis for little visitors.

To avoid the spread of nits, please check their heads for live lice and eggs and remove them a nit comb. The Wet combing method is very effective, especially when used with a basis hair conditioner, however you can buy lots of products from the supermarket or chemist which kills both the lice and eggs.

It is recommended that you repeat the treatment at least once or twice to thoroughly make sure all eggs and lice have been removed.
