You were all brilliant!

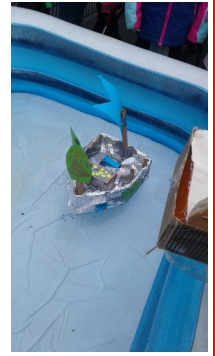




Year 2 Sailing Boats
