We packed our bags ready to be evacuated. We discussed and compared what we would want to take with us. It was exciting and nerve-wracking all at the same time thinking about where we might go!



Year 5 Perlethorpe Trip

On Monday, Year 5 went to Perlethorpe to experience what life was like for an evacuee during WW2. They took part in an orienteering activity around the grounds searching for bomber and fighter planes belonging to both the Axis and Allied powers. They experienced what life would have been like in the classroom whilst being billeted to new homes...No one wanted to be billeted to mean Mrs. Tideswell! They also had the opportunity to explore genuine artefacts dating back as far as 1935 before taking cover in an Anderson shelter.

'Today was fun...The part I really liked was the scavenger hunt. I was scared of Mr. Ryder. He said Mr. Rathe was allowed to slap me across the face if I did wrong... Luckily, I was good!'
