The Year 1's really enjoyed sharing this time with the Year 4's and said that they would love to do it again!

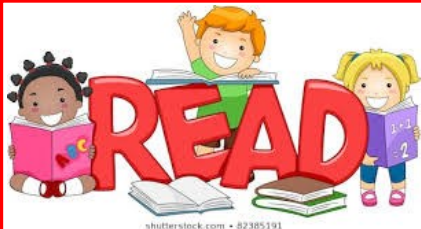
