
Also, just a reminder - all of F1 will now do PE on a Monday (both morning, afternoon and 30 hours children).





#### KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 1 are looking at Traditional Tales and have focused on Jack and the Beanstalk. We have listened to alternative versions such as Jack and the Baked Beanstalk and have looked at the similarities and differences in the different versions. We have been looking at how the text and the illustrations can give the reader clues as to how a character is feeling and how they might say things. We practiced joining in with familiar parts of the story and used a loud voice when the text was in CAPITALS or in **bold**. We have tried to use our voices to show the different characters and their feelings when we have been role playing the story.



### KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

In maths we have been learning about Statistics. We went outside to create bar charts based around our favourite animal. We then looked at which option was the most or least popular, the sum of more than one option and the difference between two options. We enjoyed learning outside and being active in maths.



### KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Year 5 are learning about space this half term and twe have been learning about the phases of the moon. Observing the shape of the moon at night and look at how it changes over the month. You could even try keeping a moon diary at home.
