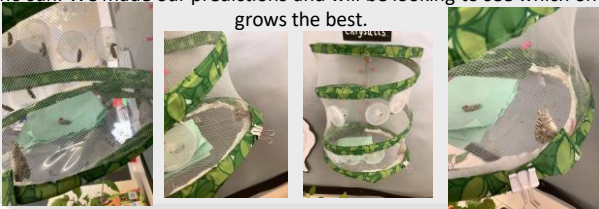

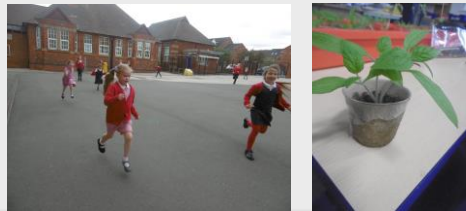
EYFS

In F2, we have been learning about different lifecycles including the lifecycle of a butterfly. So far, we have watched our caterpillars go into their chrysalis. On Friday, one butterfly came out! We can't wait to see the rest of the butterflies. We have also been learning about the lifecycle of plants this week and testing to see whether cress will grow in 3 different conditions: water and sun; sun and no water; water and no sun. We made our predictions and will be looking to see which one grows the best.



KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Y2 have been looking after the plants that we are growing for our 'Let's Get Growing' vehicle. They all seem very strong, and we are looking forward to using our tomatoes to make a healthy sauce for pizzas! As part of our investigations as to what we need to do to keep healthy, we have also been learning about the impact of exercise on our bodies and have undertaken a fitness routine to discover what the impact will be. It's certainly been fun to get out and run about in our 'Daily Mile'!



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 4 have been looking at the artist Stephen Wiltshire to create some Jubilee artwork for the queen.

Stephen Wiltshire was an autistic artist who drew cityscapes completely from memory (sometimes after only seeing them once).

We practiced using ball-point pen, pencil and imprinting with oil pastels.

Do the leaves on the trees look different?

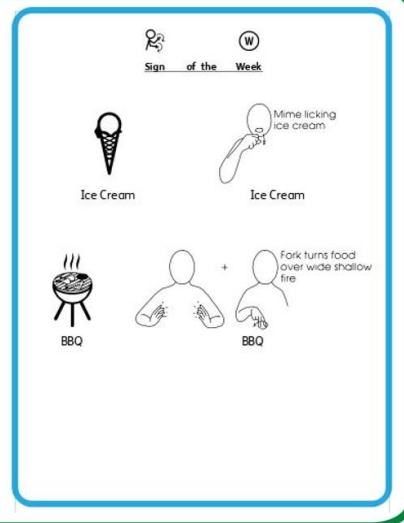
Can you see anything else on the trees?
