KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Dr Charlotte May (from Nottingham University) visited year 6 to discuss her career and links to History. Dr Charlotte May explained how she has a degree in English literature, a master's degree and a PHD. Dr May explained to the children how she uses skills such as reading and writing everyday in her job. Her job (researcher) involves research, talking to the public, writing museum guides and writing papers that are published.

She explained that she studies writing from the 1700-1800s and sometimes it can take up to 4 hours to work out one word alone as grammar was so different in the past. The children asked questions about her job, her future and how they could to university.
