What they have looked at so far in their vehicle work.

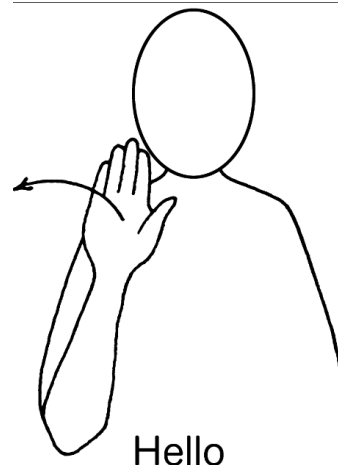
What they can recall from the text we have all looked at "Rain before rainbows".

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

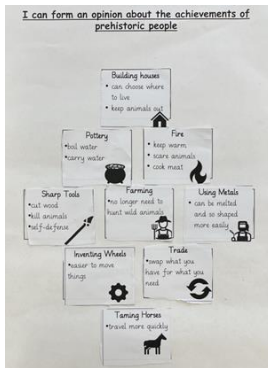
