KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

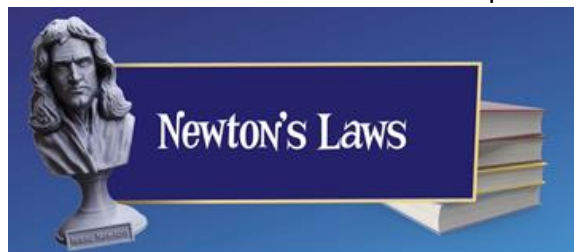
Year 4 have been learning more about the Romans and how to run their museum this week at Mansfield Museum. Here are a few photos of what we got up to.

Alton Towers Workshop

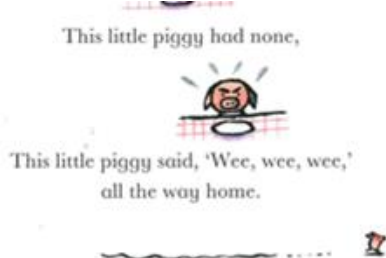
