

# Newsletter

On **Friday 14th October** we will be raising awareness of DLD (Developmental Language Disorder) in school and are asking children to **come dressed in yellow and purple**. DLD Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) is when a child (over 5) or adult has difficulties talking and/or understanding language.



Children will often: Speak in shorter sentences or use less sophisticated vocabulary than other classmates. They often don't understand what is said and often get told 'you weren't paying attention' when in fact they were paying attention but could not understand the language. Some students with DLD may be over literal or have difficulties with conversational skills.

**DLD is a lifelong condition: children don't grow out of it.**

It impacts on: Reading, Learning, Social interaction, Behaviour and Mental health

These difficulties impact on education and social interactions and can often affect self-esteem and mental health.

Research shows that 2 children in every class of 30 suffer from DLD. On the 14th October the children in school will be learning about DLD and completing a range of activities to support their understanding of how a child or adult with DLD may feel.
