

This week the children in Year 1 have started their new vehicle Once Upon a time. We have started by looking at the story of the Three Little Pigs and have begun to think why the house of straw and the house of sticks was blown down by the wolf.

We have been investigating materials and their properties, what they can be used for and why we may choose some materials for specific purposes. We have learnt lots of new words to help us categorise different everyday objects and had lots of fun sorting different classroom objects according to their properties!

We even found that some objects could be made of two different materials and so could fit in to two different

categories.
