Year 4 Mansfield Museum Trip

This week our year 4 classes went to Mansfield Museum on a Roman Day which links into their 'Horrible Histories' vehicle.

During the morning, the children experienced life as a Roman Soldier including learning about the uniform and kit they had and the training they had.

After that they looked at Roman architecture and industry including Roman baths and toilets. The children were very shocked to learn that Romans used to wipe their bottoms using a sponge on a stick.....which they shared with the person next to them!

After lunch, the year 4's were given a tour of the museum and shown how to create an exhibition which they shall be doing at the end of half term for parents.

They got lots of good ideas of things to do including Roman Games, clothes, art work and much more.



Healthy Lunch Box

We would like to share with you some examples of healthy lunchboxes.

At school we recommend you put 3 items in your child's lunchbox, including a sandwich (or substitute) a snack and a healthy desert. This could mean a sandwich, a packet of crisps and a yoghurt, but you may wish to add in another snack for your child such as carrot sticks.

There should be no fizzy drinks and children should only have chocolate in the form of one chocolate biscuit from a multipack.

The children have also worked hard creating their own Roman togas (including emblems) and Roman shields, using a variety of different skills and techniques.

As with all Museums, we will not be charging an entry fee but we will be selling a small variety of refreshments (hot and cold drinks).
