We even looked at how some of McDonalds' packaging is designed and had a go at designing some ourselves too.

Next, we went over to the *Make Building* and watched our sign being printed using a digital printer. We met some of the staff in Prelim' who showed us how printing only uses 4 colours, which are all layered over the top of each other to make every other colour.

Another member of staff showed us how the big lithographic printer could print 1,000's of sheets an hour for much bigger jobs.

Finally, we watched our signs being cut-out using yet another machine and not only did we bring signs back to school for our new rooms but, we each got to take one home too.

We had an absolutely fabulous morning and want to thank all the staff at Linney, who were so kind and welcoming to us and even offered us a job!

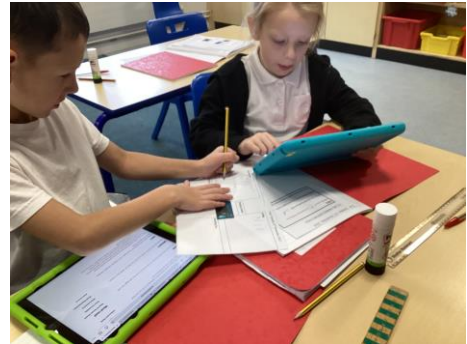
EYFS
