What might it be like when you get up in the morning?

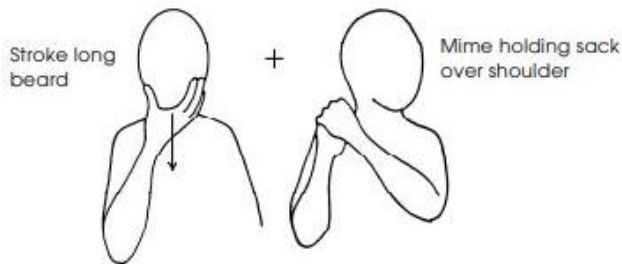
What might you do to keep warm?
