EYFS




KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 4 have started their new vehicle this halfterm all about the Anglo Saxons. The Anglo Saxons came to Britain after the Romans, so we are making lots of comparisons between how they lived. We are also reading the epic Anglo Saxon poem

"Beowulf" - which we love!



In Year 2 we have been looking at the Subordinating Conjunctions: because, when, if. We used Rainbow Grammar cards to write our sentences. These sentences were linked to our English text Sick Simon. It is also supporting the children's understanding of our Vehicle work this term called Gruesome Germs.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This half term we have started our new vehicle on plastic pollution. We completed a live online lesson with Severn Trent water. The children learnt about how we need to reuse our water bottles to ensure that we are reducing our plastic pollution. We discussed reusing bottles or making sure we recycle them.
