KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 1 had a visit from Kristen from Lion Learners to start off their new vehicle Fur, Feather and Scales. They were able see, touch and learn about mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and invertebrates and learnt the features of each animal group. They learnt lots of new vocabulary and found out which animals were carnivores(meat eaters), herbivores (plant eaters) and omnivores (eat plants and meat). The children even got to hold a snake and a tarantula! The children thoroughly enjoyed this hands-on experience and would like to say a massive thank you to Friends of Sutton Road who donated the additional funds to cover the cost of this experience.



KS2 (Years 3 and 4)
