Does it remind you of a story you have read?

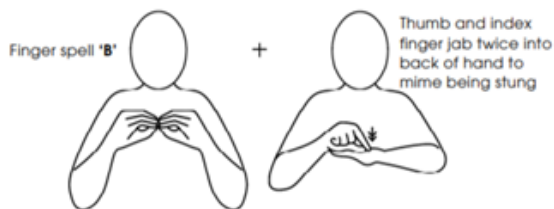

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

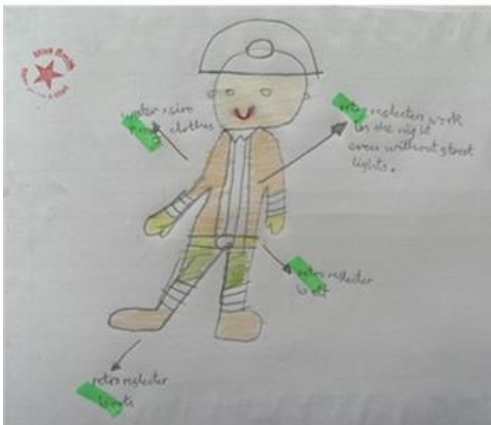

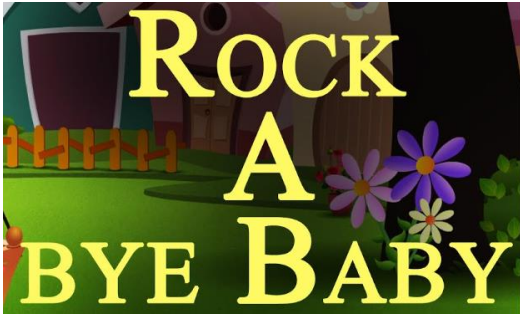


KS2 (Years 5 and 6)
