KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

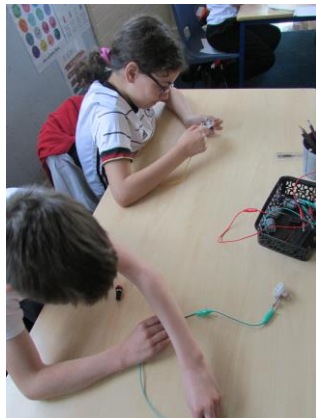
In Year 2 we have been looking at the still life artist Nora Heysen. We have painted vegetables using our skills of colour-mixing and dabbing with small brushes.

We have already learnt so much from our English and Reading texts and have since had the opportunity to explore circuit components to see how they work.

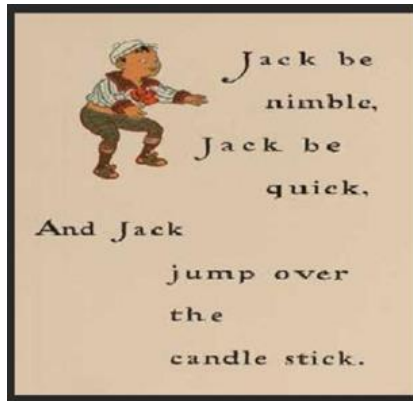


KS2 (Years 5 and 6)
