Sutton Road hosted the league plate finals for the Y5/6 Mansfield School Games football league.

Our third game was against Flying High. We had previously played this school earlier in the year and won the game. However, they had a much-improved defence, they cleared the ball well and their goalkeeper made some incredible saves this kept the game to 0-0 getting a 2nd draw of the afternoon.

The final was against Northfield Primary, who had the same record in the group stage as us winning 2 and drawing 2 so we knew this would be a tough game. About 5 minutes into the final a corner was played in and although it was bouncing around it ended up in their net making it 1-0 to Sutton Road. Mr Marshall then went into panic mode and put 4 defenders on the pitch in a 7 a side game. This worked and the final whistle went on a historic afternoon for the school.

Sutton Road won the plate competition, and all the team received a medal!
