We've had a busy but wonderful time in F1, settling in and exploring the nursery. We've been having fun outside, painting pictures, reading stories, creating with the playdoh and much more! We even had a very wet 'Treetop Tuesday' this week in our Forest School. Please remember wellies and waterproofs every Tuesday. Thank you, F1 Team

Year 1 started their vehicle Marvellous me by naming body parts and looking at their 5 senses. They learnt which body parts are responsible for each sense and have investigated how their sense of smell, taste, touch and hearing help them to understand the world about them. They enjoyed testing their sense of taste and smell and found out it was tricky to identify different smells and tastes without their other senses. They were great at identifying different sounds that they could not see.



Year 3 have been settling in and starting to explore their first Vehicle 'Hunter Gatherers'. For the next term, we will be learning all about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. This week we went out onto the school field to make a timeline showing when the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age was. We have also been researching early Stone Age people and discovering different pre-historic animals.

This week, year 5 have enjoyed learning all about evacuees. We have explored an evacuee suitcase and its contents, researched the main reasons children were evacuated at the time and role-played becoming evacuees ourselves!
