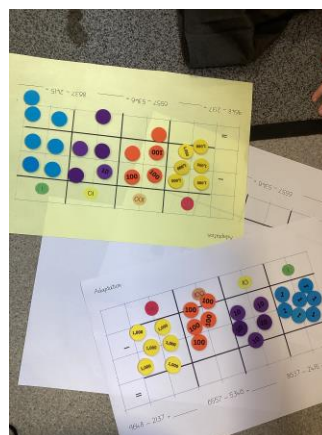
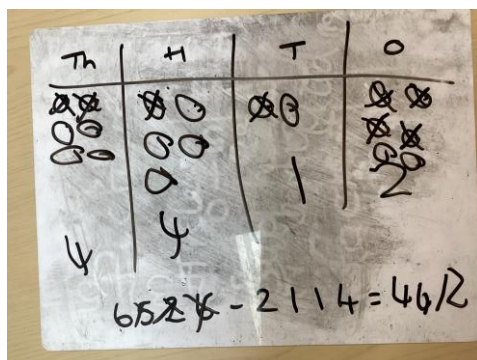
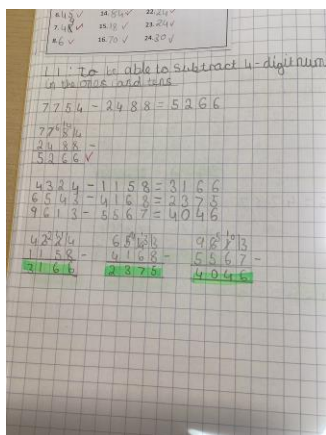
Year 2 have been celebrating Monster Phonics Day.

We all dressed up as our different monsters from our phonics scheme and took part in different activities.

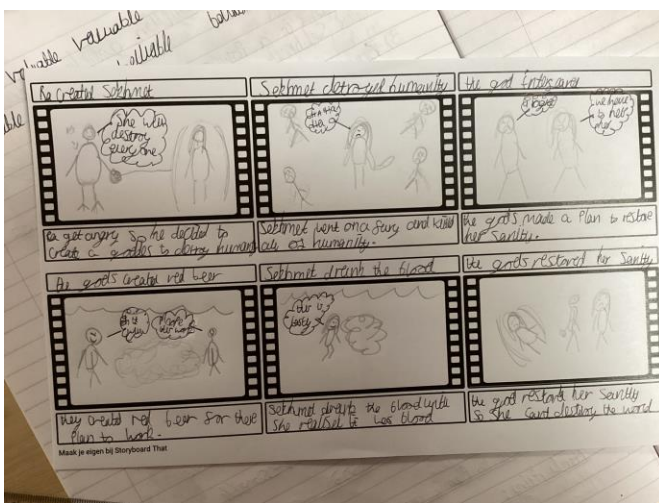
We created our own monster hats then all of year 2 met in the rave cave for a party!

Could we ask parents/carers to please label your children's clothes, including PE kits and outdoor coats with their name.

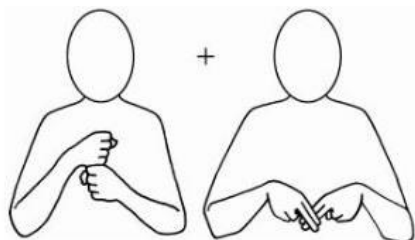
