This week in Nursery, we took our maths outside to Forest School. We have been exploring patterns in maths and the children were asked to create a repeating pattern using things they could find outside. The work produced was brilliant as you can see from some of the pictures!

Year 1 have started a new vehicle Who lives in a place like this? They have learnt about human features (those made by humans eg roads, shops, houses factories) and physical features (those made by nature eg mountains, oceans, seas, rivers, hills). They have learnt the 4 compass points (North, East, South & West) and have completed field work looking at features around school in these directions.







Year 3 have been learning about the importance of the Harvest Festival to Christians, we created our own seed pictures as a symbol of thanks to God for a good harvest

Last half term, Year 5 were learning about WW2 in Britain.

We had a VE Day celebration afternoon where we sang 'We'll meet again'. There was lots of singing and dancing as part of this celebration where the children bought in party food which everyone was in year 5 was invited to share as part of the celebration. We have also enjoyed creating some artwork in celebration of Remembrance Day.
