*Reading Forum have selected 61 new books from the free books that we earned in the last book fair! These will be arriving in school soon.





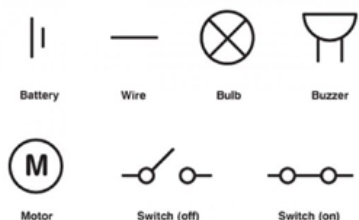
