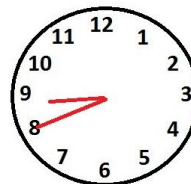

4AO – 2-3pm Monday 18th December

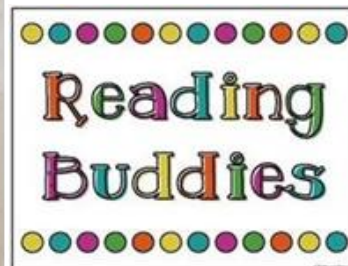
4DB – 2-3pm Tuesday 19th December

Reading update

Aren't they cute! We now have Reading Buddies in our small hall library waiting for you to come and read to them! As part of our vehicle, we have been looking at things that make us belong. We have been talking about uniforms and how they can show where we belong. Some of us in nursery wear uniforms to show we belong to our school. We have also looked at people who help us, such as police officers and paramedics, to see what uniforms they wear. We have loved dressing up!

Year 1 have been investigating how to make materials stronger. They learnt that triangles are strong shapes and that paper can be made stiffer and stronger by folding it or rolling it into cylinders. The children worked in teams to create a strong structure from sheets of paper. They tested their structures by putting books on to see if they was the strongest.



In year three, as part of our Talking Points lessons, we have been having discussions around who can keep us safe. We decided that there are many people who can look after us and keep us safe, such as police officers, nurses, firefighters, teachers etc. However, our family members were definitely the clear favourites!  - Telephone the school office on 01623 455920

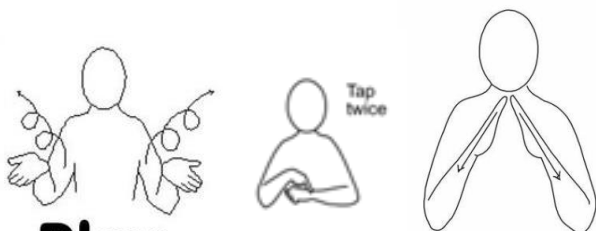
Key Information
