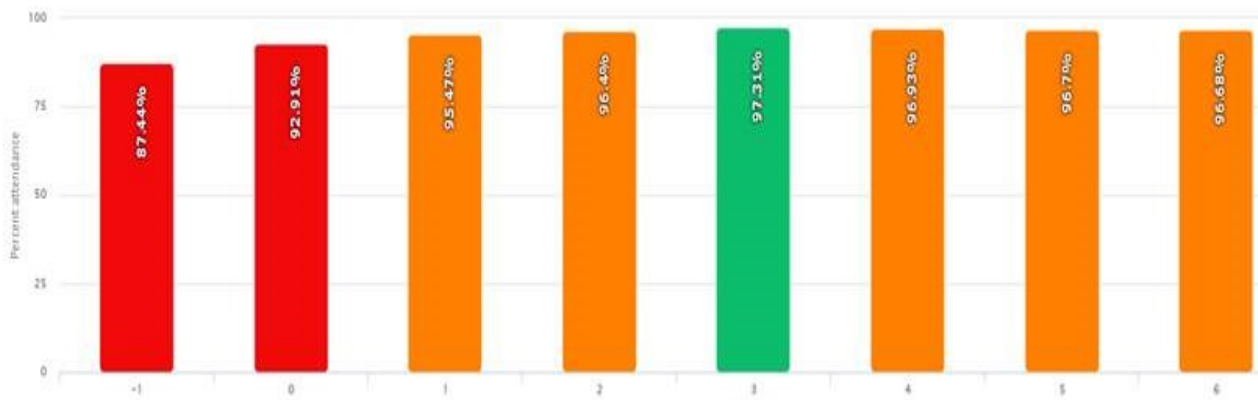
Shop for Schools
