



We are looking for professional people who have the skills required to contribute to effective governance and the success of the school. Your skills may include personal attributes, qualities and capabilities, such as the ability and willingness to learn and develop new skills as well as skills you may have obtained through your work.

Governing bodies are responsible for a wide range of matters which come under three main headings:

Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;

Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, and the performance management of staff; and

Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

Governors need a strong commitment to the role and to improving outcomes for children, the inquisitiveness to question and analyse, and the willingness to learn.

The governing body of Holgate Primary School / Sutton Road Primary School would specifically welcome nomination from people with the following skills:

- > a level of legal experience at a management level within previous or current employment
- > a level of human resources experience at a management level within previous or current employment
- > or a level of experience of managing premises within previous or current employment

As an effective governing body, we seek to secure or develop within our membership as a whole, expertise and experience in

- analysing performance data,
- budgeting and driving financial efficiency,
- performance management and employment issues, including grievances.

We seek to recruit and/or develop governors with the skills to work constructively in committees, chair meetings and to lead the governing body.

Our governors serve a four-year term of office (even if your child leaves the school during this time). We meet 3 times a year as a whole governing body and have 2 committees who usually meet 2 times per term. There is an expectation within our code of conduct that each governor will become a member of a committee and will take on additional responsibilities as a link governor. All governors are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct adopted by the governing body.

We offer a full induction package, a mentoring system and availability of in-house, central and online training packages.

Holgate and Sutton Road Primary Schools' Person Specification for Governors

At our collaborated Primary & Nursery Schools we believe the appointment of any governor should be to support the school to drive improvements which have a positive impact on the educational provision and outcomes of our schools. Therefore, when selecting a governor, the following skills and attributes are requirements for any potential applicants:

	Had a senior or leadership role in any profession
	Has experience of working in an educational setting or similar public service-related business
	Has knowledge and some management experience of current site and buildings Health & Safety
