#### **Year 6 Leavers Hoodie**

We are co-ordinating the ordering of leavers hoodies once again this year. We will be ordering them from a local company: The Schoolwear Centre in Mansfield who supply our branded uniform. We have secured a flat rate of £16 each for all the hoodies – Adult sizes will incur an extra £2.40 charge which includes VAT.

We have secured a bid from our FSR Parent group who are very kindly covering £11.00 of the cost of the hoody. Therefore, the cost of our hoody's this year for our Year 6 pupil is only £5.00 each (or £7.40 for adult sizes).

We recognise that this is such a significant milestone in our children's education and we want to help them to celebrate this with a leaver's hoody.

Please can we receive your order (via the letter sent out) and all payments via Parentmail by **Wednesday 20th March 2024** for us to receive delivery of the hoodies before the end of May.

This will be in time for the Year 6 leavers photographs on 6th June.



#### World Book Day (Thursday 7th March 2024),

As part of our World Book Day celebrations, Bookworms Book Fair will be in school again from **Monday 4th March to Friday 8th March**. Reading Forum have ordered 80 free books from our last 2 book fairs. These will be delivered to school when the book fair returns. We will share these with you when they arrive.







In Nursery, we have been looking at patterns in maths.

We created patterns in forest school and in class!

Year 1 have been working with Mr Kemp and have painted in the style of David Hockney. They produced an artist study, looked at a variety of his work and learnt that he often painted the same scene at different times of the year. He used the paint brush to stroke and dab and often painted colours on top of what he had already painted to create detail. Year 1 developed their mixing skills and used these to make different shades of brown and green.








Year 3 have started a new vehicle which is all about mining. To give the children an idea of what mining might have been

Year 5 have had fun investigating about Water Resistance involving play dough and water. We also looked into Air Resistance making our own Gyrocopters.

We would like to invite all children to come to school wearing something RED.


We know there's a lot going on right now and for many people things are really tough, but if you are able to make a donation, every penny will add up to make a life changing difference.
