John Radford Trophy Success for Sutton Road

On Monday, the Sutton Road year 5 football team travelled to Mansfield's RH Academy to take partina qualification round for the John Radford Trophy 2024. There were 10 teams, where only two could qualify. We were placed in a group with 4 other schools and played a round robin, having to finish top to qualify for finals day.

Our first game started brightly with some attacking chances, but none hitting the back of the net, arguably this game was the most challenging as we were slow to settle into the competition. A 0-0 draw saw us take 1 point from the first game but a solid stance to move onto the next game.

Game 2 was a slightly different story where we held off the attackers well, changed our shape and came out 2-0 winners with goals from Kian and Oscar B sealing our first win and 3 points, again another clean sheet was really encouraging.

Game 3 saw a solid performance with our changed shape really working, even if players were not in their natural position, we worked amazingly together seeing another win this time 1-0 and an awesome goal from Fraiser beating 3 players to slot the ball in the corner of the net. 7 points from a possible 9 and we were looking at the top two spaces with our challenges still to play.

Game 4, our toughest challenge with King Edwards also looking at the top spot, we knew a win would see us move to finals day in the John Radford trophy, the team were really resilient with two injuries before the game started, we knew it would be tough. The defense and midfield managed to repel their attack and a late goal from Kian saw us move to the finals day finishing top of the table.

Reminder School Start Time


Can we please ask that children are on site by 8.35am to be ready for the School day ahead.
