Dear Parent/Carer

To support our learning this term, **year 3** will be visiting Pleasley Pit on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2024** for a '**Mining Heritage**' themed day. Pleasley Colliery (known locally as the Pleasley Pit) is a remarkable historic site on the Nottinghamshire Derbyshire border. As a scheduled ancient monument, these Victorian pit buildings have been lovingly developed and maintained by the Land Trust and Pleasley Pit Trust. During the day, we will discover fascinating stories by exploring their interactive museum and experience first hand recounts of life down the mines. This site is a dedicated charity with a team of passionate **volunteers**.

We will be leaving school by coach at around 9:10am and will return to school at approximately 3:00pm for you to collect your child. If we do arrive back later than home time, can you please allow us to get the children off the coaches and back into classes. You will then be able to collect the children from the classes as normal and we will be able to keep the children safe.

Your child will **not** need to wear their school uniform on the day. Please send them in warm clothing and waterproofs and sensible footwear as much of the day will be outside.

So that we keep food waste to a minimum, could you please let us know on ParentMail by **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024** what food choice you would like for your child. **Your choices are:** 

- A school packed lunch for children on Free School Meals or Universal Free School Meals.
- Your own packed lunch from home.

Can everyone send their child with a drink from home (non-fizzy and no glass bottles) and a bag to store their food.

In order for the visit to take place we require a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of the bus of **£7.66** per child. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will not be able to take place. School does not make a profit and all parental contributions will be used to pay for the trip. **Pleasley Pit do not charge for the tour and visitor experiences**, though they have asked if we would **make a voluntary contribution to them** in order to help to maintain this amazing experience for children in the future. All of the additional contributions will be passed onto Pleasley Pit.
