Don't forget there is also the Monster Phonics Website and there is also a Monster Phonics Facebook page.

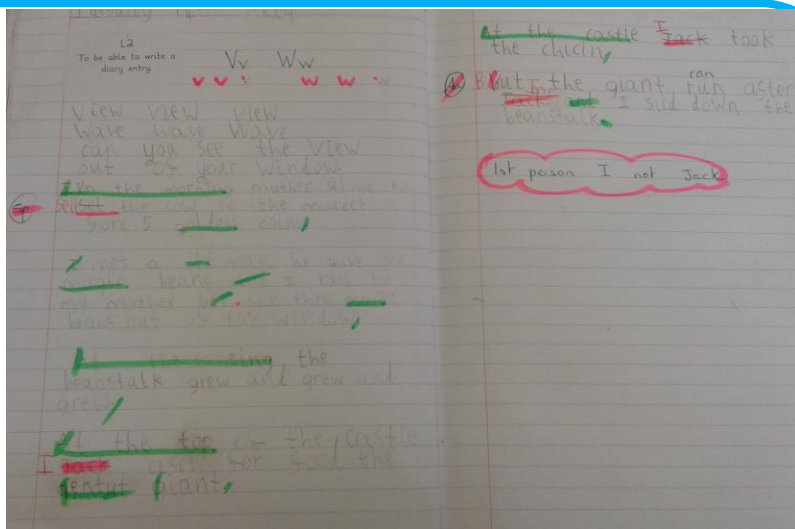
We hope this is useful for you to help your child with their knowledge of phonics, reading and writing.

After a month of looking after them and watching them change from a caterpillar, we said goodbye to our beautiful butterflies in Nursery. They had all emerged from their cocoons at the start of the week, so we gave them orange and apple slices as well as sugar syrup to help them get strong enough to fly away. We will miss watching them.

Year 1 have written diary entries based on Jack and the Beanstalk. We took on the role of Jack and wrote in 1st person. To make our diary entries engaging for the reader, we used fronted adverbials to open our sentences in different ways and added interesting adjectives.



Y3 have been scientists and have been experimenting with light, looking at reflective materials and which materials would be best for using on a book bag. In order to find out about this, we have investigated a range of these surfaces, and which reflect light better. We enjoyed collating this together in groups and found that light travels in straight lines, and that some lighter surfaces, when a beam of light is shone onto them, reflect almost as much light back.



Year 5 have been finished creating their own computer game. Next we are planning to evaluate and play each others!

Year 5 have also enjoyed learning about Alexander the Great and the influence he had and the things he helped to develop.

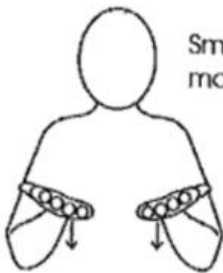
