

Respectful Parking reminder

We would just like to remind Parents and Carers that when dropping off or collecting their Children not to park close to where the Children are crossing for the safety of all road users.

Please

DO NOT park or pull up on the zigzag marking outside school or near the cones as this area is designated for our families and children to cross safely.

DO NOT be rude or discourteous when speaking to our school crossing staff

AND please ensure you follow the Highway code when it comes to parking outside our school, which states that drivers MUST NOT park their car...

- Near to the entrance of a school.
- Anywhere that would prevent access for the Emergency Services.
 - In front of or on an entrance to someone else's property.
 - On a road bend.
- Opposite a road junction or within ten (10) meters (32 feet) near junctions or corners (except in authorised spaces).
 - Anywhere the kerb is lowered. This is usually done to assist powered mobility vehicles and wheelchair users.

Please help us to keep our children and families safe.

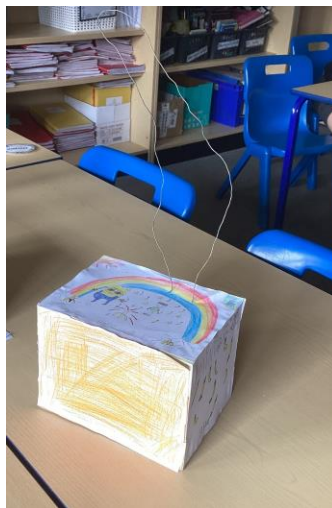

Year 2 have been studying the artist Nora Heysen who painted still life pictures of vegetables. We created our still life paintings by colour mixing and adding white or black to make tints, tones and shades.
