The food that is collected at this point, will either be used to support our own families or provide supplies for local foodbanks. 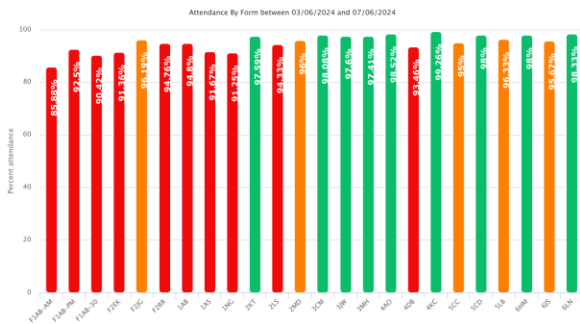

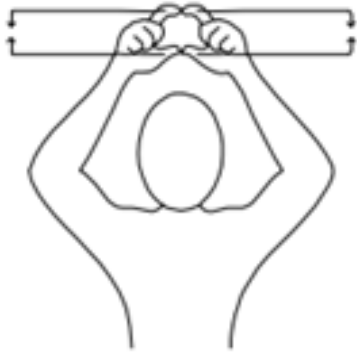
