



Summer Fest Raffle Tickets


Virtual Raffle tickets for the Summer Fest are now on sale at 50p per ticket via Parentmail.

Holidays in term time

Unfortunately, our attendance is being severely affected by holidays being taken in term time.

So far this year, 1893 sessions of learning has been lost for those children, due to holidays. As a result, over 80 Penalty Notice Applications have been submitted.

From September, the government are making significant changes to attendance. The first penalty notice issued to a parent in respect of a particular pupil will be charged at £160 if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days.

A second penalty notice issued to the same parent in respect of the same pupil is charged at a flat rate of £160 if paid within 28 days.

A third penalty notice cannot be issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the date of issue of the first. If a third holiday is taken, within those 3 years, the Local Authority will take alternative action. **This will often include considering prosecution, but may include other tools such as one of the other attendance legal interventions.**

Don't get caught out by the new government changes and end up in court!

Absence Monitoring

Our policy states that when a child is absent for 3 or more days, regardless of the reason, they will be issued an **Attendance Alert Letter**. Our Attendance officer will then be monitor attendance over the coming weeks.

If we feel no improvement has been made, we offer support through our **ATTEND programme**. The ATTEND framework which has been developed to be used collaboratively with parents / carers and pupils. The framework is designed to capture, in one place, any underlying barriers which may be impacting on children's attendance and try to support.

If the offer of an ATTEND meeting is declined and no improvement is made, a formal warning letter will be issued, and you will be given a period in which we need to see an improvement in attendance.

Finally, if during this time attendance does not improve, we are left with no option that to complete a Penalty Notice application to the Local Authority, and you will be liable for a fine.

Please support and ensure you child attends school every day.


