Dear Parent/Carer

To support our learning this term, Year 3 will be visiting Creswell Craggs on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2024 for an 'On the Hunt' themed day with a tour around their largest cave, a survival skills workshop, and a Stone Age animal safari.

We will be leaving school soon after the start of day (8:40am) and will return to school at approximately 3:15pm for you to collect your child. As we are scheduled to arrive back later than home time, can you please allow us to get the children off the coaches and back into classes. You will then be able to collect the children from the classes as normal and we will be able to keep the children safe.

Your child will **not need to wear their full school uniform**. We would suggest **warm clothing and waterproofs if you have them** as much of the day could be outside and sensible footwear - we suggest **trainers or wellington boots**. All children will need a packed lunch and a drink (not fizzy or in a glass bottle) in a suitable bag. However, if your child receives Free School Meals, a lunch will be provided for them by school. Free School Meals children will still need to bring a drink.

In order for the visit to take place we require a voluntary contribution of £13.00 per child. The PTA have very kindly made a financial contribution towards this trip in order to bring the price down to this cost. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will not be able to take place. *School does not make a profit and all parental contributions will be used to pay for the trip.*

Please ensure to pay for the visit via ParentMail by 31/10/2024 and tick the parental consent box at the checkout.

We also need parent volunteers to support on the trip for the day in order for it to go ahead. If you are able to help, please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible.
