Attendance

Our school attendance target is 97%

Last week our attendance stood at 95.58%

Although this is below our target, it is above the national average, so our school is doing absolutely amazingly.

We still have 133 children with 100% WOW

We have 92 children who are currently classed at PA children (below 90%)
