As a part of your child's education at Sutton Road Primary School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that, during the final half term, starting 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme. These lessons are statutory in Primary schools and are part of the science and PSHE curriculum. The only lesson which isn't statutory is lesson 4 on how a baby is made and you can withdraw your child from this session if you wish. Lessons in year 6 will include pupils learning about puberty, becoming more independent, positive healthy relationships and how a baby is made. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. All PSHE teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.
