As part of our year 6 leaver's celebration our children will have the opportunity to have their face painted and or have glitter tattoos applied and the Friends of Sutton Road have bought coloured powder to throw in the air similar to the powder used in the festival of Holi.

For children to take part in these activities we need the following permissions please:

By signing this consent form, you are giving staff at Sutton Road Primary School your permission for your child to have a Glitter tattoo applied or their Face Painted and you are indicating your acceptance of the terms and conditions below.

CONSENT FORM FOR GLITTER TATTOO.

Terms and conditions:

- If you have skin allergies or sensitivities, we advise you do not get a Glitter tattoo.
- Temporary Glitter tattoos can last up to a week with proper care: Do not scrub directly on them. /when bathing, simply allow water to wash over your tattoo. Do not apply soap on a tattoo.
- If you need to remove your tattoo, wipe the tattoo gently with oil (baby, coconut, olive etc). You may also wipe gently with an alcohol wipe or rubbing alcohol applied to a towel. You may need to repeat this step several times until the tattoo is removed completely.
- Staff at Sutton Road primary are not liable for any reactions that may occur from the tattoo product that we use.

CONSENT FORM FOR THROWING COLOURED POWDER.

By signing this consent form, you are giving permission for your child to take part in the coloured paint throwing celebration.

To prevent any staining to special clothes, we recommend that children either come to school in older clothes (that can get stained) or bring something to change into. The children will be asked to change towards the end of the celebration. The coloured powder is made from corn starch, dyed with food grade colouring.
