Curriculum Overview	Children will learn about their family as well as exploring the different types of families. Children will explore how they have grown for a baby to a child and how they will continue to grow. Links will be made to animals and plants around them and how they also grow and change. They will explore how celebrations can be similar and different, share their own experiences, and learn why people celebrate important times.
