

**Maths****Challenge 1:**

Ask a grown up to take you to the shop (or make your own) and give you 15p in 1p and 2p coins. What can you buy with 15p? How many things can you get with 15p? Did you have any change? How much? Did you see something that you didn't have enough money for? How much more did you need? Can you send a picture of what you got? Could you write a price tag for them? Happy shopping!

**Challenge 2:**

Can you name the 3D shapes? Are there any shapes within the shapes?  
How many corners are there?  
Are the sides straight or curved?  
Can you find any of the 3D shapes at home or outside?  
Can you send a photo of the 3D shapes you can find?

**Challenge 1:**

Gordon has to be careful he doesn't burst. What was it in the story that could have popped him? Can you make a list of other things that Gordon needs to keep away from? Remember when you write a list each word goes underneath each other.

**Challenge 2:**

Take your balloon somewhere in your house or garden. Can you draw a picture of him? Then can you write a sentence telling us where he is. So, if your balloon is called Fred you could write, Fred is in the bed.

**Challenge 3:**

Using the photos from your balloon adventure can you write your own balloon adventure story. Remember it needs a beginning, middle and an end.

**Challenge 1:**

**Flashback**

In the story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff why do you think the Troll was so grumpy? Do you think someone had been nasty to him? Do you think he had any friends? What could you say to the Troll to help him make new friends?

**Weekly Learning Project****Challenge 1:**

Ask a grown up if you have a balloon (or ball) to take on an adventure. Give your balloon a name, tie some string to him so that he doesn't escape. Then take him on an adventure. Take photos of where he has been on his adventure. Please send these to us so we can see where you've been. Remember to keep him safe!

**Challenge 2:**

In the story Gordon has to be tied to Penelope so he doesn't float away. Can you put Gordon in the bath and see what happens, does he float or sink? Can you find other things that float? Can you send your pictures of what floats and sinks?

**Challenge 3:**

Go on a walk with an adult (don't forget to take your balloon) When you get back can you make a map so that if your balloon escapes he can get home safely. Don't forget to write labels for him.

Write a note for your friend who you are missing, tie it to your balloon and send it on its way.
