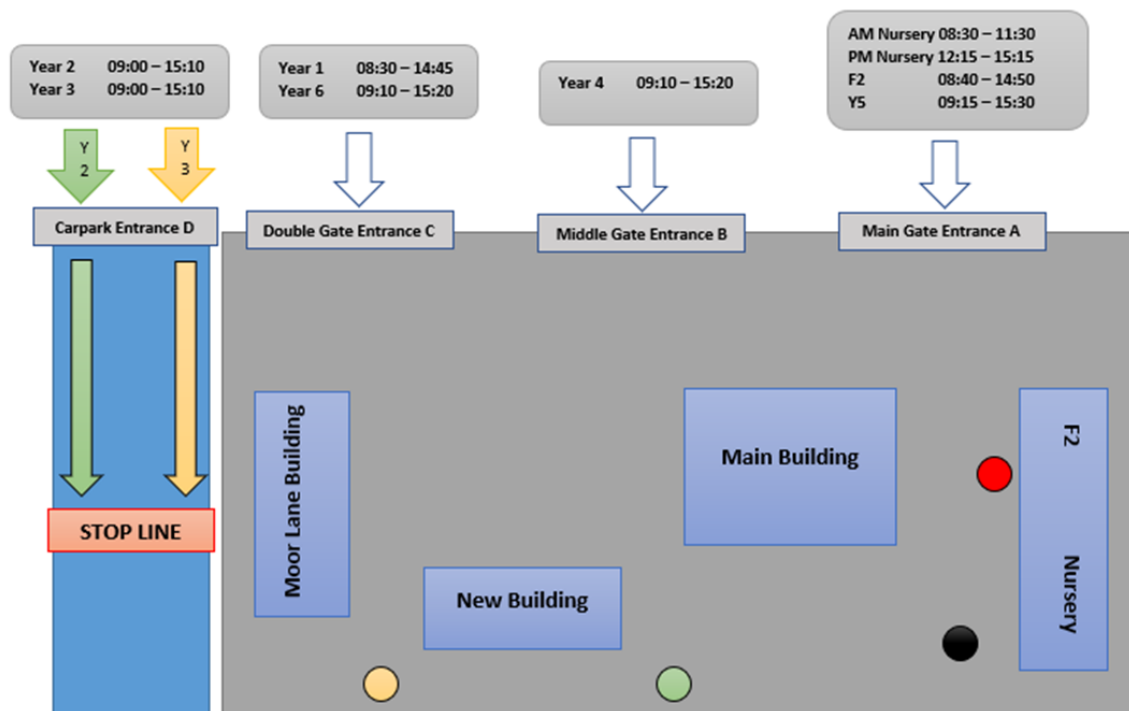
We are on a very tight schedule in the morning to get children into class so we need to keep disruptions to a minimum.

## Start and End of the Day

Staggered starts and ends to each day for different year groups will be running to ensure safer drop-offs and pick-ups and less people on the school site at any one time and parents must not arrive earlier or later than these **only one adult per child**. Please line up at the allocated gate.

To support safety and ensure social distancing we ask that parents and pupils walk to school wherever possible. No bikes or scooters will be allowed on site until further notice.



Please remember:

Children are to be brought to school by one single adult. Where possible for older children we are encouraging them to walk to school independently.

Please do not arrive early, each year group must arrive at their allocated time.

If you have more than one child, all siblings to be dropped off together with the youngest child and **collected at the latest allocated time**.

If possible, we ask that parents walk to school as there is not the space to park on the street outside school.

After dropping your child off at school please leave the premises and vacate the pavements outside of the school as quickly as possible to allow for the next year group children to arrive. Safely. Remember if you need to speak to a member of staff, please contact the school office for support or ask for a message to be passed on and the class teacher will contact you.

## Hygiene

Please speak to your child about the importance of hygiene measures. Staff will continue to insist on regular handwashing and hand sanitising.

The 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' approach is crucial, and children will be reminded of this regularly. We have already increased our cleaning of frequently touched surfaces and toilet and sink areas, and this will continue across the school.



## Lunch Times

Children will need to bring their own packed lunch if they are in Key Stage 2 and are not entitled to a Free School Meal. This will be the case until October half term when we will review the situation and write out to you again regarding school meals provision.

For the time being, all children will be eating their packed lunch in the classroom due to not being able to have large collections of pupils sharing lunchtimes in the hall.

Children will still be entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals if they are in F2, Year 1 or Year 2 and also if they are in Key Stage 2 and entitled to free school meals and will be provided with a packed lunch.



We would like to share with you some examples of healthy lunchboxes.

At school we recommend you put 3 items in your child's lunchbox, including a sandwich (or substitute) a snack and a healthy desert. This could mean a sandwich, a packet of crisps and a yoghurt, but you may wish to add in another snack for your child such as carrot sticks.

There should be no fizzy drinks and children should only have chocolate in the form of one chocolate biscuit from a multipack.

## Other Important Info

On returning to school, all our children will;

Be expected to return to school in full school uniform

Be expected and supported to behave in a safe way at all times

Need to bring their own clearly labelled water bottle to school each day

Be following strict handwashing and hygiene procedures

After the first week back, be required to come to school in their PE Kits on PE days which will take place outside as much as possible. Information about days for PE will be sent out during the first week back.

Be able to bring a small named bag with essentials in e.g., reading book, packed lunch (if required) and water bottle. They will be provided with all the stationary resources they need so we ask them not to bring any stationary or pencil cases in from home.
