If you are taking a photo of the work that your child(ren) has done, we would recommend using a mobile phone with the

Teams app installed on it. To do this, take a picture of the work you want to hand in, then go into Teams on the phone and choose the assignment that you want to hand in work for, click the '+ Add work' option underneath the 'My Work' title in this assignment and then 'Upload from this device' to access the image. Remember to click on 'Hand in' your work to receive feedback.
