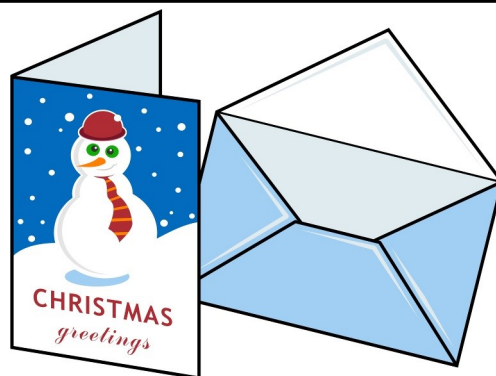
If your child would like to send Christmas Cards to friends in their class, they can do, but we must ask that they follow the below instructions:

The total raised for the **Poppy Appeal** this year was £158.50

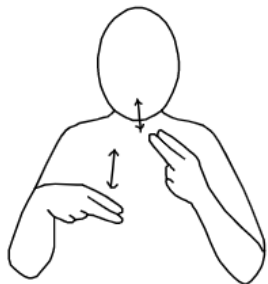
Children in Need raised an incredible £499.12 so once again a huge thank you!
