EYFS

This week in F2 we have had our Science Week, the children have had lots of fun with our different topics over the week. We started off the week looking at 'Changes in Us' and we talked about how humans grow from babies all the way into elderly people. We talked about how we have changed since we were all babies. Then on Tuesday and Wednesday we have investigated 'How Plants Grow' and what the plants need to grow. The children amazed us with their knowledge on growing, they listened to the story 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle and we discussed why it is important not to pick flowers that are trying to grow. The children held an experiment using cress, they planted cress in soil and also wet paper towel to test if the seed will grow in both? On Thursday and Friday we investigated how to be healthy and why it is so important we are healthy. We made a yummy fruit salad and talked about our favorite healthy foods to eat. On Friday we finished the week investigating 'Our Teeth' and why it is important to keep our teeth healthy. We used eggs and the drink coke to find out the effects of sugary drinks on our teeth.

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

In Year 1 we have been busy in our first week back! We have launched our Summer vehicle of Glorious Gardens/ Bee Happy and we have learnt about the job of a garden designer and looked at lots of different gardens and then created our own. We have also been working with a fantastic author Luke Temple and creating our own monsters and settings. The children have created some very imaginative monsters and we are very proud of them all.

KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have started creating miniature Stone Age outfits. This week we have created a template of our outfit, copied this onto fabric and decorated it to look like animal skins. We can't wait to begin sewing these together next week!



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

On our first day back, year 6 took part in a virtual trip to the Holocaust Centre. We attended Leo's Journey Workshop and a live webinar with a Holocaust survivor. It was very interesting and moving as we were able to learn about what happened during Kristallnacht.
