This week we have carried on exploring and enjoying our topic of 'Growing'. Last week we sent home our sun flowers and it has been lovely to see the pictures coming through on TEAMS of the progress of all of the sunflowers at home. This week we have planted our own cress heads in school, and we held an experiment where we are testing whether a cress head can grow without water and if a cress head can grow without any light. The children have loved checking on their cress heads each day. Today in our Forest Schools we hunted for things that are growing on our field; we found flowers, pear and apple trees, daisies and berries. 
