"This week in Fresh Air Fridays we have been finding and looking closely at different minibeasts. We had lots of fun out on the field. ## KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 2 are investigating germs this term. The science investigation question is Is it important to wash your hands? We have 4 slices of bread on display to find out which one has the most germs growing on it. One slice was touched with hands that had been cleaned with soap, one slice has been touched with hands using hand sanitiser, one slice has been touched by dirty hands and the final slice is our control. It has not been touched at all. The slices are in sealed bags and we are waiting to check them next week. The children have already predicted that the dirty hands slice will have the most mould growing on it! We shall see if the soan and sanitiser have worked!



## KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 4 have been looking at the Romans this half term. We have already looked at the Roman invasion of Britain and know the Emperor Claudius was successful in taking over Britain in 43AD. We have also looked at the building of Hadrian's wall to keep out the 'Picts' and we are looking at the importance of Boudicca. We are also really looking forward to our Museum trips!



### KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

Year 6 has started their Vehicle this week - 'Scream Machine'. As part of this we have been looking at ordinance survey maps. We explored the symbols on the key and tried to find key land marks. We managed to find Drayton Manor!

What have they learnt so far in their lessons? What they hope to learn?


Have they learnt any new vocabulary?
