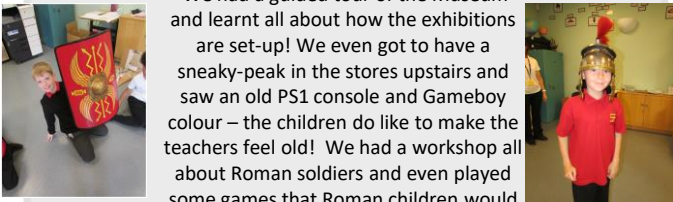


KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

4AO loved their trip to Mansfield Museum!

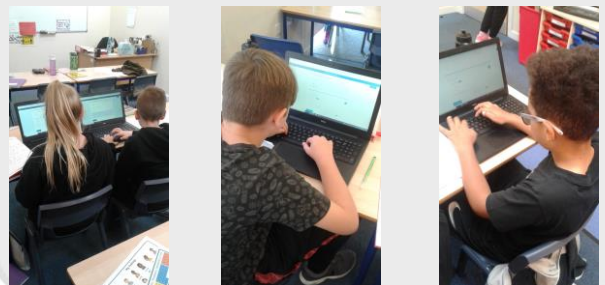

How is it different to last week?

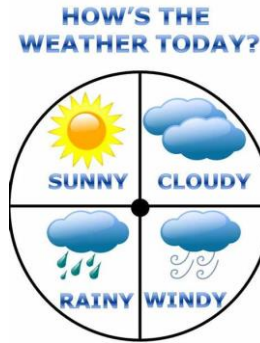
Do they know why the weather has changed?
